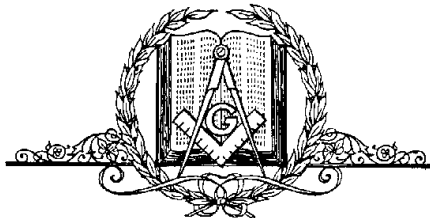

Brethren,

I have several things to call to your attention this month. First is the issue of Dues, we have twenty-nine Brothers who have not yet paid their 2010 dues. Seven of these members have not paid their 2009 Dues putting them in danger of being suspended for NPD. We all realize the problems with the economy the past few years and if you are in a financial hardship and can not pay your dues this needs to be brought to the attention of the Lodge to keep you in good standing. If this is not the case I would ask that you remit your dues ASAP to keep you in good standing.

Next a reminder to all coaches and candidates, I would ask all the coaches to please keep me informed of any Brother who has passed off proficiency so I can note such on the Brothers records. To the candidates and coaches remember the time limits for progression in the EA and FC of Two Years and a Master Mason must pass proficiency within 90 Days of his Master Mason Degree, we have two Master Masons who have exceeded this time limit and several more candidates that are pushing the two year mark. I would encourage all coaches to get with their Candidates and encourage them to complete the required work.
